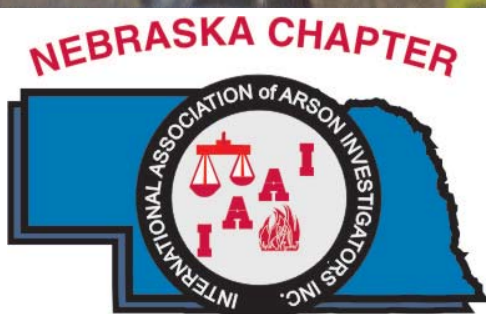

Conference Presenters

Lester V. Rich, CFEI, IAAI-CFI

Mr. Rich holds a Bachelor of Science degree, Appalachian State University, and was certified by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives as a Special Agent Fire Investigator in 1997. His experience includes firefighter, County Fire Marshal and Fire Investigator for the Charlotte Fire Department. A Specialist in Explosives and post blast scene investigation. He is a sought after instructor having taught internationally and domestically, including as a visiting lecturer at the National Academy.

He is a Certified Fire Investigator by the International Association of Arson Investigators and the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications. Certified Fire and Explosion Investigator by the National Association of Fire Investigators. Certified in Blasting Fundamentals and as a Hazardous Materials Technician/Specialist.

He has over 3,500 hours of specialized instruction, investigated over 850 fire scenes, participated in over 375 test and training burns. He has provided expert testimony in both state and federal courts including testimony in civil and criminal cases as to both accidental and incendiary fire causes

Mark A. Teufert

Special Agent Mark A. Teufert began his career with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and Explosives in October 1992 following service in the United States Army as a Field Artillery officer. Special Agent Teufert was initially assigned to the ATF Field Office in Memphis Tennessee. He was selected for the ATF Certified Fire Investigator Candidate Program in 1995 and became an ATF Certified Fire Investigator in 1998. Following his assignment in Memphis, Special Agent Teufert served as the Certified Fire Investigator Program Manager at ATF headquarters in Washington, DC. He is currently the State and

Local Training Program Manager assigned to the ATF Arson Training Branch at the National Fire Academy in Emmetsburg, MD.

Special Agent Teufert received a Bachelors' degree in 1985 from Belmont College in Nashville Tennessee with a major in Information Systems Management. He is a member of the International Association of Arson Investigators and serves on the IAAI Fire Investigations Standards Committee. Special Agent Teufert is a committee co-chairman on the Technical Working Group for Fire and Explosions and is a member of the CFITrainer.net Steering Committee. He previously served on the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Advisory Committee on Arson. Special Agent Teufert is also a Certified Explosives Specialist and is a member of ATF's National Response Team.
